How Much Does This Permit Cost?

Permit Fees

The fee for single family installations is \$236.70. For all non-single family residential projects, including commercial projects, the fee includes:

- Application fee of \$55.20
- Review and inspection fee of \$89.70 per hour of time required
- Documentation fees of \$1.38 per plan page and \$0.69 per letter size document based on the number of documents to be recorded
- CPF* fee of 15% of the plan review and inspection fees
- SMIP** fees based upon the total valuation of the installation
